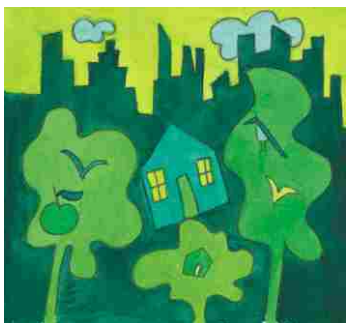

Theatre of Image kids' workshops are different from others because every child gets to experience three different disciplines - **Drama, Art & Music** - within two full stimulating days running from 9-30am to 4.30pm.

Creative Process

We emphasise the creative process, focusing young energies to tackle problem-solving in their artistic quest - building their self-confidence and giving them a great sense of achievement.

We promote a team spirit in building creative ideas. This increases awareness of the joys and benefits of creative collaboration and camaraderie in the arts and in general life.

These workshops put young people in touch with a broad choice of artistic facets in the performing & visual arts and are lots of fun.

5-7 year-olds focus on encouraging individual imagination, collaboration, teamwork & the joys of creative play.

8-10 & 11-12 year-olds focus more on skills, learning actual techniques in **Drama, Art & Music**.
